
Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-563.01, the Town Council of Pinetop-Lakeside voted to approve the proposed alternative expenditure limitation - home rule option at its special meeting on June 28, 2018. The vote for approval was **5** For and **1** Against.

At the general election to be held on November 6, 2018, the voters of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside will vote on the question of an alternative expenditure limitation - home rule option.

With voter approval, the town shall be limited to the expenditure of estimated available revenues whether such expenditures are less than or exceed the State imposed limit. As an example, in 2019-2020, the state-imposed limitation, without applicable constitutional exclusions, will allow expenditures of \$6,419,110. Under the proposed alternative expenditure limitation, we estimate expenditures of \$12,647,342.

If the voters approve, the additional expenditure authority will be used for all local budgetary purposes including all services and operating costs. Revenues received from federal, state and local sources will be used to fund such expenditures.
