RESOLUTION NO. 14-1308

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, ESTABLISHING A SALARY EQUIVALENT FOR PURPOSES OF COMPUTING WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE PREMIUM AND COMPENSATION BENEFITS FOR NON-POLICE VOLUNTEERS AND ADMINISTRATIVE POLICE DEPARTMENT VOLUNTEERS.

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statutes § 23-901.6 provides that volunteer workers of a Town may be deemed to be employees and entitled to workers' compensation benefits upon the passage of a resolution or ordinance by the Town defining the nature and type of volunteer work and the number of workers to be entitled to such benefits. The basis for computing compensation benefits and premium payments shall be Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per month; and

WHEREAS, the Town has previously provided workers compensation coverage for Volunteers In Policing (VIP) workers in the Pinetop-Lakeside Police Department and state statutes provides coverage for law enforcement authorized reserves and volunteers.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the salary equivalent for non-police volunteers and administrative Police Department volunteers of the Town under A.R.S. § 23-901.06 is Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per month for the purposes of premium payments and compensation benefits under the workers' compensation provision of the Arizona Revised Statutes, to be effective April 17, 2014; and

Section 2. That the number of volunteer positions within the Town eligible for coverage under the workers' compensation coverage shall not exceed 30, and the nature and type of work is non-police volunteers and administrative Police Department volunteers of the Town.

Section 3. That the Town Manager or Finance Director are authorized to execute any and all documents that may be necessary to establish workers' compensation coverage for all non-police volunteers and administrative Police Department volunteers who are eligible, and to keep the coverage provider informed on the number of volunteers, their assignments and duties, and the identity of those who are covered.


