RESOLUTION NO. 16-1382

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON AUGUST 30, 2016.

WHEREAS, the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Navajo County, Arizona did hold a Primary Election on the 30th day of August 2016, for the election of six Council Members; and

Whereas, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Navajo County, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That the total number of ballots cast at said primary election, as reported by Navajo County, was 1,033.

Section 2: That the number of ballots rejected was 8.

Section 3: That the votes cast for the candidates for the 2 special two-year terms for Council Members expiring November 2018 were as follows:

Norris Dodd	584
Robert Bersok, Jr.	416
Patrick Place	399

Section 4: That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record, that Norris Dodd and Robert Bersok, Jr. each did receive a number of votes greater than the majority vote calculation for the office of Town Council member and are hereby issued certificates of election, effective November 8, 2016.

Section 5: That the votes cast for the candidates for the 4 regular four-year terms for Council Members were as follows:

Section 6: That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record, that Kathleen Dahnk, Carla Bowen, Jerry Smith and Jim Snitzer each did receive a number of votes greater than the majority vote calculation for the office of Town Council member and are hereby issued certificates of election, effective November 8, 2016.

Section 7: **THAT** the total number of votes cast for Proposition 408, regarding direct election of the Mayor of Pinetop-Lakeside, was as follows:

Section 8: **THAT** it is hereby found, determined, and declared of record, that Proposition 408 was passed and approved.

Section 9: **THAT** this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
