

TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE

RESOLUTION NO. 17-1392

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR REGIONAL CONNECTOR TRANSIT SERVICES BETWEEN THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE AND THE CITY OF SHOW LOW, NAVAJO COUNTY, NAVAJO COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT, TOWN OF TAYLOR, AND TOWN OF SNOWFLAKE.

WHEREAS, the participants to this Intergovernmental Agreement desire to continue to engage in regional coordination and cost-sharing to provide a reliable and inexpensive regional connector transit service to benefit their community, organizations, and the public in general; and

WHEREAS, the Four Seasons Connection was established in May 1997 and the White Mountain Connection was established to meet this need and began operation in January 2009; and


WHEREAS, this Intergovernmental Agreement is intended to establish the framework for the participants to fund regional connector transit services for the White Mountain Connection and the Four Seasons Connection for a one-year period, with two successive automatic renewals; and

WHEREAS, Navajo County, the City of Show Low, Navajo County Community College District, Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Town of Taylor, and Town of Snowflake, are authorized by Arizona Revised Statutes Section 11-952 to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona, hereby authorize the participation in the Four Seasons Connection and the White Mountain Connection for a one-year period, with two successive automatic renewals, and approve the Intergovernmental Agreement for Regional Connector Transit Services.




