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**Note 1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

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The Annual Expenditure Limitation Report (AELR) is presented as prescribed by the *Uniform Expenditure Reporting System* (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes §41-1279.07. The AELR excludes expenditures, expenses, or deductions of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §20 from the total expenditures, expenses, or deductions reported in the fund financial statements.

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the AELR is presented below for any exclusion claimed on Part II and each subtraction or addition in the Reconciliation that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the fund financial statements. All references to financial statement amounts in the following notes refer to the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balances for the Governmental Funds.

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**Note 2. Debt Service Requirements**

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The exclusions claimed in Part II for debt service requirements are summarized as follows:

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**Note 3. Investment Income**

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The exclusions claimed in Part II for grants, aid, and contributions from private organizations consists of \$2,500 received from private organizations, and \$6,711 received in library donations reported in other revenue.

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**Note 6. Contracts with other Political Subdivisions**

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The exclusion claimed on Part II, Line B.10 of \$175,606 which consists of \$81,324 for dispatch services, \$18,732 for a lease with Apache County and \$75,550 for a public transit agreement with Show Low are included in the financial statements under general government as charges for services.
