Individuals are limited to three (3) minutes.

Pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(1)the Council may vote to enter into Executive Session:

appropriate but not less than twenty-four hours for the officer, appointee or employee to determine whether the discussion or consideration should occur at a public meeting.
