

**TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE**

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-1502**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF A PROJECT FOR CONSIDERATION UNDER THE FORT MCDOWELL YAVAPAI NATION, PROPOSITION 202, 2019 STATE SHARED REVENUE PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, the passage of Proposition 202 by the voters of Arizona in November 2002 set the stage for new gaming compacts between the State and the respective tribes. An important provision of Proposition 202 was the sharing of gaming revenues with the State. A portion of the revenue to be shared can be retained by a tribe and distributed itself. Specifically, Proposition 202 states:

“The Tribe shall make twelve percent (12%) of its total annual contribution under Section 12(B) in either or both of the following forms:

- 1) Distributions to cities, towns, or counties for government services that benefit the general public, including public safety, mitigation of the impacts of gaming, or promotion of commerce and economic development.
- 2) Deposits to the Commerce and Economic Development Commission Local Communities Fund established by A.R.S. Section 41-1505.12.”

The Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation is currently receiving applications for programs and projects that focus on education, public safety, health, environment, and economic and community development. As such, the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation, invites eligible cities, towns and counties to apply for 2019 Arizona Benefits Funds Grant as part of its ongoing commitment to giving back; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, through the Pinetop-Lakeside Police Department, is interested in submitting a project to be considered for funding in the form of a 100% reimbursable grant through the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation, Proposition 202, 2019 State Shared Revenue Program – Arizona Benefits Funds Grant;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona as follows:

1. THAT approval of the submission of a project for consideration through the Fort McDowell, Proposition 202, 2019 State Shared Revenue Program – Arizona Benefits Funds Grant is granted.
2. THAT the Chief of Police or his designee is appointed agent for the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant, and assign in-kind resources.


