

## TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE

### RESOLUTION NO. 22-1645

#### **A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Navajo County, Arizona did hold a General Election on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022 which was administered by the Navajo County Elections Department for the purpose of Alternative Expenditure Limitation (Home Rule Option), Proposition No. 430 and one (1) two-year term Council Member; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town Council and attached as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Navajo County, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said General Election, as shown by the Navajo County Election Official Report, was 2,031.

Section 2. That the number of ballots rejected was 6.

Section 3. That the total number of Registered Voters is 2,791.

Section 4. That the Voter turnout was 72.77%.

Section 5. Proposition No. 430 was submitted to the voters to consider a resolution proposing an alternative expenditure limitation for the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona. Descriptive Title: Pursuant to the Arizona State Constitution, this proposal establishes an alternative expenditure limitation for the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside for the next four years. Annually, the Town Council will determine the amount of the alternative expenditure limitation for the fiscal year after at least one public hearing. This alternative expenditure limitation replaces the state-imposed expenditure limitation. The votes cast are set forth below.

Proposition No. 430	Total Votes For	Percent of Votes
A “ <b>YES</b> ” vote shall have the effect of establishing an alternative expenditure limitation for the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside.	1,038	56%
A “ <b>NO</b> ” vote shall have the effect of not allowing the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside to establish an alternative expenditure limitation and to require expenditures of the Town to be limited by the state-imposed expenditure limit.	813	44%

Section 6. That it is hereby found, determined, and declared of record, that Proposition No. 430 - Alternative Expenditure Limitation (Home Rule Option) was approved by the electors of the Town voting at said General Election.

Section 7. That the votes cast for candidates of the two-year Council Member seat were as follows:

Section 8. That it is hereby found, determined, and declared of record, that the following candidate did receive the necessary majority of the total number of valid votes cast for the office sought and is hereby issued a certificate of election:

Section 9. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
