Amending Title 16 Chapter 16.24.140 Water System

Chapter 16.24
DESIGN STANDARDS

16.24.140 Water system.

A. Each lot **WITHIN A PROPOSED SUBDIVISION** or building unit shall be supplied with potable water in sufficient volume and pressure for domestic use and fire protection purposes. Design and construction of any and all facilities relating to the supply, storage, transmission, treatment and distribution of potable water within ~~or outside of~~ any subdivision must ~~meet with~~ **RECEIVE** the written approval of the water provider and ~~Pinetop THE Fire District or Lakeside Fire District.~~
