RESOLUTION NO. 24-1699

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, APPOINTING Jeffrey Phillips TO SERVE ON THE PINETOP-LAKESIDE TOWN COUNCIL AS A COUNCIL MEMBER WITH A TERM ENDING NOVEMBER 2024.

WHEREAS, A Notice to the Public advertising a vacant Council Member seat was posted and published in the White Mountain Independent on December 12, December 15, December 19, and December 29, 2024 inviting interested individuals desiring to serve on the Town Council to submit a Letter of Interest, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council received Letters of Interest from citizens interested in interviewing for a Town Council vacancy, and

WHEREAS, four individuals completed the required application process. All applicants are over 18 years old, qualified electors (registered in Navajo County), and have resided within the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside boundaries for at least one year prior to appointment, and

WHEREAS, all four applicants were interviewed during a Regular Meeting of the Town Council held on January 18, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council that Jeffrey Phillips, residing in the boundaries of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, is hereby appointed to serve as a Council Member of the Pinetop-Lakeside Town Council. The term of this appointment will expire in November 2024, if the appointed Council Member wishes to fill the vacant seat in its entirety (Ending November 2026), he/she must run in the Primary Election on August 6, 2024 and be elected, or the General Election on November 5, 2024 if needed.
