A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO 2025 ARIZONA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY, HIGHWAY SAFETY CONTRACT 2025-II-005:

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety sought out proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety; and

WHEREAS, the Pinetop-Lakeside Police Department submitted a project for consideration of funding in the form of a reimbursable grant through the FFY 2025 Governor's Office of Highway Safety, Highway Safety Plan. The department was awarded funds totaling \$4,000, through Highway Safety Contract #2025-II-005 (Exhibit A).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona as follows:

1. THAT approval of Highway Safety Contract #2025-II-005 is granted.
2. THAT Chief of Police Dan Barnes and/or his designee is appointed agent for the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.



The Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) has completed the review of the proposals submitted for funding for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2025 commencing on October 1, 2024. All of the proposals were carefully considered by an evaluation team at GOHS that reviewed agency performance, program priority area, problem identification, supporting fiscal/data documentation, consistency of reporting, and available funding levels.

As a result of this evaluation process, we are pleased to be able to include your agency's submitted proposal(s) listed above in the **Arizona's FFY 2025 Annual Grant Application (AGA)** to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). However, please be aware that your agency's awarded highway safety project(s) may not have been funded at the amount requested and may be subject to change as we strive to make the best use of federal taxpayers' dollars.

All FFY 2025 grants will begin on October 1, 2024 as long as NHTSA approves the FFY 2025 AGA. If approval from a Town/City Council or Board of Supervisors is required, your agency should begin the process of scheduling the grant award for approval.

The assigned GOHS project coordinator will be contacting you regarding your project(s) and your agency should have the grant(s) soon. **During the interim, do not make any public announcement concerning the grant and do not incur any costs or proceed with any portion of the project until GOHS has written a grant agreement with your agency and it has been signed and executed by both parties.**
