

FALL FESTIVAL PARADE

Entry applications for the 2024 Fall Festival Parade on September 28 are now open on the Town's website. This year's parade theme is "Ruby Jubilee" and will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the incorporation of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside on July 31, 1984. So far, 16 entries have been received, including the Town's entry that will depict birthday cakes in honor of its 40th birthday.

COLOR FUN RUN

The ever-popular Color Run will be back on Saturday, October 12, at Woodland Lake Park. This year, the Town is partnering with the Chamber of Commerce for Pinetop-Lakeside to host the event. The Color Run is a free event where participants run or walk the one-mile paved path around the lake and have colored powder showered on them at various points. While there is no charge to participate, Color Run packets featuring T-shirts, sunglasses, and face coverings are available for purchase for those who want one.

AUTUMN FEST

Autumn Fest will be back for its second year and the Community Services Department has begun planning the event scheduled for Saturday, October 26, at Mountain Meadow Recreation Complex. The event will be similar to last year's inaugural Autumn Fest with carnival games, a chili cookoff, live music, retail vendors, food trucks, costume contests, and a beer and wine garden sponsored by the Rotary Club of the White Mountains.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT TOPICS OF INTEREST

Rob Hephner, Creative Services Specialist, attended the Arizona Housing Forum August 21-23, at We-Ko-Pa Casino. Rob returned with some valuable information and insights into the future of employee housing. He will share what he learned with Town staff in September and will work to implement some of the ideas as the Town strives to increase workforce housing.

Work is nearly complete on the Town's Economic Development Plan. The plan will be reviewed by the committee that worked to put it together in September, then the Community Services Department will present it to the Town Council for approval, likely on September 19. The Community Services Department was charged with creating the plan as part of the Town's Five-Year Strategic Plan created in 2022. Once adopted, the plan will be posted to the Town's website.

The Community Services Department is preparing to launch a new program that will allow the public to become more familiar with Town Council and staff. Each month, a Town Council representative or staff member will be featured on a podcast and will contribute an article to "Talk of the Town," produced twice a month by Marketing Coordinator Annie DeRosier. Council member Lynn Krigbaum will be the first person highlighted as part of the program designed to increase transparency in government.

The Community Services Department is working closely with Arizona Water Company on “Leave It Better,” a water-conservation program to be launched at Run to the Pines on September 28 and 29. Arizona Water and Blossom Marketing videotaped a message from Mayor Stephanie Irwin to be included in an educational video to promote water conservation in the White Mountains.

The Town will resume its largely successful “Coffee With Council” on Tuesday, September 10, at 11 a.m. at Pinetop Coffee House. Coffee With Council is an opportunity for community members to discuss topics of interest with Town Council members in a casual setting. Mayor Stephanie Irwin and Councilmember Lynn Krigbaum will participate, along with Public Works Director Matt Patterson. Additionally, the Community Services Department has added a companion meeting called “Conversations With Council.” These meetings will have a primary topic to be discussed, will be held in the evening, and will rotate locations. The first session is Wednesday, September 4, at Camp Grace. Mayor Irwin and Vice Mayor Sterling Beus will participate in the meeting that will focus on growth and possible annexation. 




