

TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE

ORDINANCE 24-477

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO TOWN CODE TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2.04.100 MAYOR – ELECTION AND DUTIES, SECTION A.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside wish to amend Town Code Title 2, Chapter 2.04.100, Section A, to reflect the correct time of electing a Vice Mayor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA, as follows:

- Section 1. **Adoption by Reference.** Pursuant to A.R.S. §9-802, the Town hereby adopts the amendment to Town Code Chapter 2.04.100 Mayor – Election and Duties, Section A, as set forth in Exhibit A, a copy of which is on file with the Town Clerk of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona, located at 325 W. White Mountain Blvd. Lakeside, AZ 85929.
- Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance is to be effective when publication and posting pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-812 is accomplished.
- Section 3. **Severability.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, adopted by the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or any part of the Town Code adopted herein by reference, are hereby repealed, effective as of the day this ordinance is effective.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Town Council in an open meeting by the Town Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona, this 7th day of November 2024, to be effective upon the expiration of a thirty (30) day period following adoption and publication pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-812 is complete.

Exhibit A

Amendment to Town Code Chapter 2.04.100 A.

Mayor - Election and Duties

2.04.100 Mayor – Election and duties.

A. The presiding officer of the Council shall be the Mayor. The Mayor of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside shall be directly elected by the qualified electors of the Town beginning with the general election of the Town in November 2022. Any candidate for Mayor receiving a majority of all votes cast beginning at the primary election in 2022 will be declared elected as of the date of the general election without running at the general election. The term of the office of the Mayor shall be four (4) years. ~~The Vice Mayor shall be elected every other year at the first meeting in June after the newly elected Council is seated by the Council members, from their membership.~~ **The Vice Mayor shall be elected every two (2) years at the first Town Council meeting after newly elected officials are sworn in and seated on even numbered years, by the Council Members from their membership.**
